International A Levels at Bellerbys Cambridge

International A Levels are qualifications aimed specifically at international students like you, and they are a great option to help you gain a deep understanding of your subjects.

Cambridge International School

Our International A Levels are governed by Cambridge Assessment International Education, part of the University of

Cambridge. International A Levels include:

- AS examinations in June or November, at the end of your first year, which is particularly suited to science subjects where learning is modular
- The opportunity to study for an Extended Project Qualification (EPQ).

Students will study between 21 and 26.5 hours each week.

This includes:

- 5.5 hours of teaching time (per subject) – this is increased to over 6 hours if you start in January
- Extensive laboratory time to build practical skills
- 3 hours intensive tailored English support (focused upon relevant science vocabulary)
- 45 minute tutorial.

A2 A Level entry at Bellerbys Cambridge

Students who have achieved a minimum of three B grades or above at AS Level CIE (Cambridge International A Level) are able to join the second year (A2), 3 term A Level programme starting in September. This is subject to an IELTS of at least 6.0 or equivalent and a successful interview with the Bellerbys Cambridge Principal.

Wide choice of A Level subjects

Most students study the six term A Level programme and will study up to four A Level subjects. Students on the 3 term programme will study three A Levels. However long you study with us, we will help you make the best subject choice for your university ambitions. Find out about each A Level subject, where you can study it and how it links to university degrees.

ACCOUNTING

Accounting is a good choice for a diverse range of degrees including accounting and finance, computer science, economics and other business-related degrees.

Enrichment includes: Young Enterprise, visits to multinational banks and lectures.

Where can you study it? **Brighton, London**

ART

This subject prepares you for further study in all disciplines of art and design, including architecture and fashion. You will develop practical skills as well as theoretical knowledge of art.

Enrichment includes: ARTiculation, Deconstruct Reconstruct, Digital Drawing.

Where can you study it? **Brighton, London**

+ BIOLOGY

Biology A Level prepares you to study a number of science subjects such as medicine, environmental science, geology or psychology at degree level.

Enrichment includes: Senior Biology, Senior Chemistry, Medics Club, visits to the Science Museum, field trips and lectures.

Where can you study it? **Brighton, Cambridge**

BUSINESS STUDIES

This varied course covers business structures, ethics, economy, law, government and the environment and can lead to a number of business-related degrees.

Enrichment includes: Business Elite, Young Enterprise, Business Ethics, CISI Finance Course and visits to the Bank of England.

Where can you study it? **Brighton, London**

+ CHEMISTRY

Chemistry is the study of all chemical substances and how they can change. It is a good choice if you plan to study medicine, dentistry, biochemistry, natural sciences or chemical engineering at university.

Enrichment includes: Senior Chemistry Challenge, Medics Club, lectures and national competitions.

Where can you study it? **Brighton, Cambridge**

COMPUTER SCIENCE

Computer Science allows you to study topics including information representation, communication and Internet technologies, hardware, software development, and relational database modelling. You'll also be able to appreciate the ethical issues that arise with current and emerging computing technologies.

Enrichment includes: Robotics, Game Design, Creative Coding, Python Programming, Chess Club, visits to the Computer History Museum and experiencing the Oculus Rift.

ECONOMICS

Economics will give you a solid grounding for the study of business, management, finance, mathematics, psychology and law degrees.

Enrichment includes: Current Affairs, Development Economics, Economics Book Club and guest speakers.

Where can you study it? **Brighton, Cambridge, London**

+ ENGLISH LITERATURE

You will study a range of texts, looking at novels and poetry and understanding them within a wider historical and cultural context. A good subject for those interested in a wide range of degrees, particularly law, history and politics.

Enrichment includes: Creative Writing, Debating, Law Society, trips and lectures.

+ GEOGRAPHY

This subject will provide you with the knowledge and understanding of the ways in which people interact with their environment, and the opportunities and challenges an environment can present.

Enrichment includes: guest lectures, Debating and visits to the Wellcome Collection in London.

+ FURTHER MATHEMATICS

This A Level is designed to deepen your mathematical knowledge and skills. This is good preparation for a maths-based degree, such as computer science, psychology, statistics and actuarial science.

Enrichment includes: Maths Olympiad and Chess Club.

Where can you study it? **Brighton, Cambridge, London**

GOVERNMENT AND POLITICS

Studying this subject will provide you with a critical awareness of the nature of politics and the relationship between political ideas, institutions and processes. It is useful for further study in economics, history, law, politics and philosophy.

Enrichment includes: Model UN, trips to political debates in London, Current Affairs and Debating.

Where can you study it? Brighton, London

+ HISTORY

You will learn about the history of different countries and study events that have changed their culture, religion and politics. An important subject if you are considering studying law, politics, or classics at university.



Manor House

For those of you younger than 18, Manor House offers warm and friendly communal living on the northern edge of Cambridge city centre.

Residential house parents, supported by residence supervisors and overnight security staff, ensure you are safe, comfortable and well-supported 24 hours a day. Free transport is provided between Manor House and the college on weekdays.

- 60 single study bedrooms with wash basins, with kitchenette and bathroom facilities shared with three other students
- Canteen providing breakfast and dinner (known as 'half board')

McMillan Student Village

The McMillan Student Village is next to the college; a one minute walk to where you will be studying. You will live with students from the University of Greenwich and Trinity Laban Conservatoire of Music and Dance, as well as your classmates from Bellerbys College London.

- 280 single rooms with a choice of sizes
- En-suite bathrooms
- Breakfast and dinner included (known as 'half board') or self-catering
- 24-hour security, CCTV and card/key access to buildings

For students younger than 18:

Homestay

Living in a homestay is a great way to experience life in Britain. By living with a local family, you can learn more about British life and culture. You will also improve your English levels through casual conversation.



Selecting your homestay

Students who select homestay as an option are matched to a suitable host when we receive your application. Any known preferences, such as if the household has pets, are taken into consideration. Students have the opportunity to request an alternative homestay at this stage prior to their arrival.

Once you arrive (during induction), Student Services will check that you are happy with your homestay. A member of the team will visit the homestay as soon as possible if you have any concerns regarding the accommodation, cleanliness or the facilities offered.

Types of homestay:

- **Standard homestay.** Choose if you are at least 16 years old and would like to live independently, but with the support of a caring home environment.
- **Homestay Plus.** Choose if you are aged 13 to 15 years old, Homestay Plus provides extra support and supervision to ensure that you are safe and secure in your homestay.

Both options include:

- Comfortable study bedroom with a desk and wardrobe
- Breakfast and evening meals
- Weekly laundry
- Bedding and towels
- Wi-Fi and telephone access
- Support from the college Welfare Team

Homestays within 2.5km – 5km
 Journeys within this area are between 30 and 45 minutes by local bus to the college.

Homestays within 0.1km – 2.5km
 Journeys within this area are between 20 minutes on a bus and a five minute walk to the college.

22 Homestays within 0.1km – 4.2km

Host Family selection

Our homestays are local people who have free space in their homes and want to help international students settle into UK life. Your host will help you gain a deeper understanding of living in the UK, whilst you teach them more about your own culture.


We complete a secure background check on all of our hosts, which includes:

- A DBS check (criminal record check) for every member of the household over the age of 16
- Interview with host parents
- Home visit to assess the quality of the accommodation and student bedroom
- Character references
- Proof of safety compliance with documents such as gas certificates.

Ongoing checking procedure

Once a year, our hosts are visited by an Accommodation Officer to ensure the college standards are maintained. All hosts must complete a Child Protection training course, as well as show an understanding of our policies on keeping students safe. In addition to this, our hosts will attend training sessions with our Director of Student Services once a year.

Most of our homestays are located less than 30 minutes' walk from the colleges, or a short bus journey away. Your host may be a home with children, a single person or a home with other students.



Please note: Homestay in London is only available for students who are aged 16 or older. All 2 Year GCSE Pathway students in Brighton must live on campus.
