Mainstream classes

Yr 9 Students study English, Mathematics, Science, Social Studies, Health and Physical Education, Art, Drama and Dance and Music and choose 2 option subjects per semester.

Yr10 Students study English, Mathematics, Science, Social Studies, Health and Physical Education and choose 3 option subjects per semester.

Yr 11 (NCEA Level 1) Students must take English, Mathematics, Science and Recreation and Wellbeing and choose 2 additional subjects. Multi level courses are available.

Yr 12 (NCEA Level 2) Students must choose a total of 5 subjects, possibly 6 by invitation only especially if they are here for one year or less. Multi level courses are available.

Yr 13 (NCEA Level 3) Students must choose a total of 5 subjects. Multi level courses are available.

The Course

Outdoor Education at Papanui High School introduces students to our unique natural environment and develops an appreciation and respect for the outdoors. Outdoor Education students will develop skills in self-management, group support and teamwork, accepting challenges and making informed decisions using sound judgement. There is a focus on preparing the students to be independent and informed users of the outdoors.

Course work based in practical contexts including: bush craft, tramping, safety management, rock climbing, mountain biking, camping, snow skills, weather, trip planning, navigation, Outdoor First Aid, environmental sustainability and ropes course.

This includes a significant number of trips during school time. Students are expected to manage their workload and commitments.

FUTURE POSSIBILITIES

This course will develop an awareness and knowledge of outdoor environments, which may lead to further study in a range of outdoor professions including Adventure Tourism, Outdoor instruction, Eco Tourism, Conservation and Environmental education.
