MASTER OF ARTS COURSES

Master of Arts Awarded by Coventry University, UK

Raffles Singapore offers the following 1 year Master of Arts:

- **INTERIOR DESIGN.**
- **GRAPHIC DESIGN.**
- **DESIGN MANAGEMENT.**

Master of Arts - Admission Assessment.

1. Acceptance of a Master Degree application is based on assessment of applicant's qualification and portfolios (if and when required).
2. Assessment will take approximately 3-4 weeks to process.
3. On case by case basis, applicants who are not eligible and cannot gain direct entry into the 1 year Master Degree course, would be recommended for admissions into either;
 - 1 year Bachelor Degree (Top Up).
 - Or Bridging Courses + 1 year Bachelor Degree (Top Up).

Entry Requirements for 1 year Master of Arts

1. **IELTS 6.5** (with a minimum score of 5.5 across all skills) - Test result is only valid within 2 years from the date the results are issued
2. **Portfolios** in relevant/ design related works.
3. **Honours Degree 2.2** (or its international equivalent) for Lower Second Class Honours in relevant/ design related discipline.
4. **Minimum Age: 20 years old.**
5. Resume (if any).
6. Work Experience (if any) in relevant/ design related industry. Company Reference Letter (if any) - to declare that the applicant has been working in xxx company from mm/yr to mm/yr (also to state job title/ position and work responsibilities in the company).
7. Testimonials and Achievements (if any).
8. For **Design Management:** Graduates with Bachelor Degree in Creative Subject/ Design Studies, Management, Business or related subject area are eligible for admission.

IGCSE – INTERNATIONAL GENERAL CERTIFICATE OF SECONDARY EDUCATION

IGCSE - Entry Requirements

1. Intakes: **January – July.**
2. Minimum Completion of **Year 9.**
3. Minimum age: 15 years old.
 - a. Students, who are **less than 15 years old**, could be accepted for Raffles-English courses (subject to RSG Admission approval).
 - b. After completion of the English courses, students **MUST** be at least 15 years old (to start the IGCSE course).
4. **IELTS 4.5** (or its equivalents) - Test result is only valid within 2 years from the date the results are issued.

IGCSE/ GCE-O Level - L1R2 & L1R1 Credits

- a. IGCSE/ GCE-O Level students, with **L1R2 credits**, are eligible to apply for 6 months IGCSE in order to meet L1R4 requirement.
- b. IGCSE/ GCE-O Level students, with **L1R1 credits**, will need to apply for 6-12 months IGCSE course in order to meet L1R4 requirement.

Raffles - English Courses

Students, who do not meet the minimum IGCSE-English requirement of **IELTS 4.5** or its equivalents, are required to take English Placement Test (EPT) at Raffles Singapore (RSG) on the Orientation Day and before the term starts.

BACHELOR OF ARTS (HONOURS) COURSES

Bachelor of Arts (Honours)

Awarded by Coventry University, UK

Raffles Singapore offers 3 year **Bachelor of Arts (Honours) incorporating 6 month Diploma and 18 month Advanced Diploma** courses in the following disciplines:

Specialisation Courses

Under Visual Communication Programmes, Raffles Singapore offers the following 6-Month Diploma and 18-Month Advanced Diploma courses;

1. **Diploma and Advanced Diploma in Jewellery Design.**
As Jewellery Design is part of fashion accessories and upon completion of Diploma and Advanced Diploma in Jewellery Design studies, students will proceed for 1 year **Bachelor of Arts with Honours (Top Up) in Fashion.**
During their Bachelor Degree studies, assignments and projects will focus on Jewellery Design.
2. **Diploma in Visual and Media Design**
After Completion of the Diploma in VMD, students have options to choose from either one of the following Advanced Diploma;
 - **Advanced Diploma in Visual Communication Design.**
 - **Advanced Diploma in Digital Media Design.**
3. **Diploma in Animation and Game Design**
After Completion of the Diploma in AGD, students have options to choose from either one of the following Advanced Diploma;
 - **Advanced Diploma in Animation Design.**
 - **Advanced Diploma in Video Games Design.**

Raffles - English Courses

Students, who do not meet the minimum English requirements, are required to take English Placement Test (EPT) at Raffles Singapore (RSG) on the Orientation Day.

1. Minimum EPT result equivalents to **IELTS 3.5** is required.
2. Based on EPT result, a student could either be exempted from the English courses or enrolled into either 3 months Foundation English, and/or 3 months IGCSE-English or Advanced English courses at RSG.
3. English courses cannot be taken concurrently with Diploma, Advanced Diploma, and Professional Diploma courses.
4. Foundation English courses cannot be taken concurrently with IGCSE courses.
5. Students, who do not meet the minimum **IELTS 3.5** equivalency, will need to take English courses at recognised language institutions, in order to improve their English and to meet the minimum **IELTS 3.5** equivalency).
6. There are no English courses for students who do not meet the English requirements of Bachelor and Master Degree courses.

Entry Requirements

1. **Entry Requirements for 6 month Diploma**

- a. Minimum Age: 16 years old.
- b. **IELTS 5.5*** or its equivalents
- c. **L1R4 Credits** (1 English Language + 4 Relevant subjects):
 - **GCE O-Level** - Minimum grade "C6".
 - **IGCSE** - Minimum grade "D".
 - **GED** - Minimum grade "PASS".
 - **IB** - Year 1/2 with minimum grade "4".
- d. OR minimum completion of **High School Grade 10** (with passing grades of at least 4 subjects, excluding English).
- e. **Students with L1R3 credits**, will need to submit **Portfolio & Personal Statement** for evaluation on their eligibility into the Diploma studies.
 - **Portfolio** - Minimum submission of 5 pieces of artwork using any or a combination of the following media;
 - Photographs / Videos.
 - Freehand drawings.
 - Paintings / Illustrations.
 - Collage / Mood Boards.
 - Arts and Crafts (In 2D or 3D format).
 - **Personal Statement** - To submit 300 to 500 words, which reflects the portfolio submitted & the applicants' interest in pursuing their choice of programme.
- f. **Students with L1R2 and L1R1 credits**, will need to enrol for **IGCSE (International General Certificate of Secondary Education)** programme at RSG, prior to admission into the Diploma courses.

2. **Entry Requirements for 18 month Advanced Diploma**

- a. **IELTS 6.0*** (or its equivalents).
- b. Completion of Raffles Diploma.
- c. For non-Raffles students - Completion of relevant Diploma/ Advanced Diploma studies.
- d. Submission of Portfolios, Transcripts and Course syllabus are required for credit transfer assessment.

3. **Entry Requirements for 1 year Bachelor of Arts (Honours)**

- a. Minimum age: 18 years old.
- b. **IELTS 6.5*** (or its equivalents).
- c. Completion of relevant Advanced Diploma studies.
- d. Submission of Portfolios, Transcripts and Course syllabus.

*Note: Test result is only valid within 2 years from the date the results are issued.
