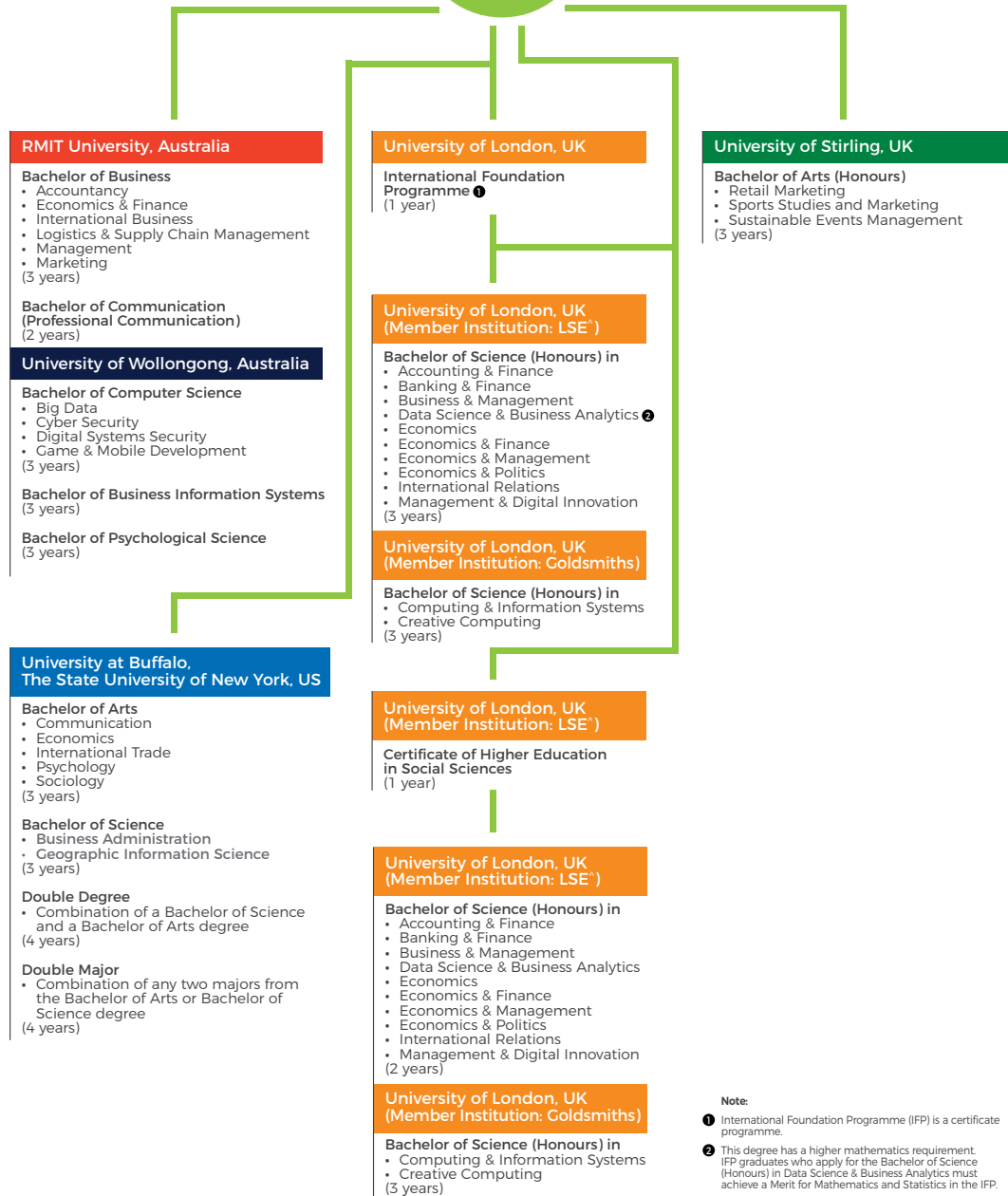

- DAC, DBF, DIB and DMS graduates need minimum grade B for each articulated subject in Bachelor of Science (Business Administration) and Bachelor of Arts (Economics); minimum 'Pass' for other exemptions.
- Foundation Studies graduates (with complete high school qualifications) qualify to apply for direct entry with no exemptions.
- For maximum automatic Recognition of Prior Learning - RPL (exemptions), SIM Diploma graduates are required to undergo and achieve B- or better for the 2 modules which they will undertake in Bridging course for Economics, Mathematics and Accounting.
- For DAC, DBF and DIB graduates: Exemptions vary between 9 and 11 modules, based on the respective entry qualification. Estimated programme duration is 2 years. DMS graduates qualify for 12 modules exemptions.
- DAC graduates with B average grades qualify to apply for direct entry; DBF, DIB and DMS graduates with B average grades qualify for direct entry after successful completion of the SIM Preparatory Course in Accounting and Finance.
- DAC, DBF, DIB and DMS graduates with B average grades qualify to apply for direct entry.
- SIM Diploma graduates who apply for the Bachelor of Science (Honours) in Data Science and Business Analytics, but do not have CCE 'A Level Mathematics (or its equivalent)', must take up the SIM Bridging Course in Mathematics and achieve a score of 40%.
- DIB and DMS graduates qualify for Year 2 with exemption from Year 1. DAC, DBF graduates qualify for Year 2 with exemption from Year 1, after successful completion of one Retail Studies module in the SIM Preparatory Course in Retail Marketing.
- DAC, DBF, DIB and DMS graduates qualify for Year 2 with exemption from Year 1, after successful completion of one Sports Studies module in the SIM Preparatory Course in Sports Studies and Marketing.
- DIB and DMS graduates qualify for Year 2 with exemption from Year 1. DAC, DBF graduates qualify for Year 2 with exemption from Year 1, after successful completion of one Introduction to Events Management module in SIM Preparatory Course in Sustainable Events Management.
- DIT graduates qualify for direct entry to Year 2 with a minimum CPA 2.0.
- DIT graduates not eligible for articulation to the La Trobe University Top-up programmes.

The regulatory regime, as set-out under the Private Education Act and its subsidiary legislation, comprises the Enhanced Registration Framework and the EduTrust Certification Scheme, both administered by the Committee for Private Education (CPE), a part of SkillsFuture Singapore (SSG)

Singapore Institute of Management Pte Ltd (SIM PL), in meeting the regulatory requirements under the Private Education Act, has put in place the following:

- Adoption of the standard PEI-Student Contract template from CPE
