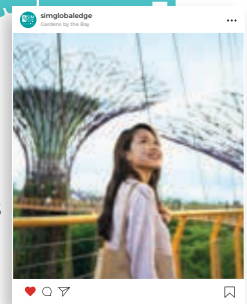

- 3 DAC, DBF, DIB and DMS graduates need minimum grade B for each articulated subject in Bachelor of Science (Business Administration) and Bachelor of Arts (Economics), minimum 'Pass' for other exemptions.
- 4 Foundation Studies graduates (with complete high school qualifications) qualify to apply for direct entry with no exemptions.
- 5 For maximum automatic Recognition of Prior Learning - RPL (exemptions), SIM Diploma graduates are required to undergo the Bridging course for Economics, Mathematics and Accounting.
- 6 DIT graduates not eligible for articulation to the La Trobe University Top-up programmes.
- 7 For DAC, DIB and DIT graduates: Exemptions vary between 6 and 11 modules, based on the respective entry qualification. Estimated programme duration is 2 to 2.5 years. DMS and DBF graduates qualify for 12 module exemptions.
- 8 DAC graduates with B average grade qualify for admission to Year 2 of the programme. Non-accounting related diplomas with B average grade will have to complete and pass the SIM Preparatory Course in Accounting and Finance (applicants from relevant business diplomas may not be required to take this preparatory course, subject to the University's approval), prior to entry.
- 9 DAC, DBF, DIB and DMS graduates with B average grade qualify for admission to Year 2 of the programme. DIT graduates with B average grade will have to complete and pass the SIM Preparatory Course in Business, prior to entry.
- 10 SIM Diploma graduates who apply for the Bachelor of Science (Honours) in Data Science and Business Analytics, but do not have CCE A Level Mathematics (or its equivalent), must take up the SIM Bridging Course in Mathematics and achieve a score of 40%.
- 11 DIB and DMS graduates qualify for Year 2 with exemption from Year 1. DAC, DBF graduates qualify for Year 2 with exemption from Year 1, after successful completion of one Introduction to Events Management module in SIM Preparatory Course in Events Management.
- 12 DIB and DMS graduates qualify for Year 2 with exemption from Year 1. DAC, DBF graduates qualify for Year 2 with exemption from Year 1, after successful completion of one Introduction to Marketing Ethics and Sustainable Marketing.
- 13 DIB and DMS graduates qualify for Year 2 with exemption from Year 1, after successful completion of one Retail Studies module in the SIM Preparatory Course in Retail Marketing.
- 14 DAC, DBF, DIB and DMS graduates qualify for Year 2 with exemption from Year 1, after successful completion of one Sports Studies module in the SIM Preparatory Course in Sports Studies and Marketing.
- 15 DIT graduates qualify for direct entry to Year 2 with a minimum GPA 2.0
